Skiing

We skied divide peak this morning. The snow surface is wind affected in some areas but SE facing slopes near the E ridge provided good skiing. We dug a snow pit at the base of Divide Peak (approx. 9300 feet, location on map below) in an open meadow south of the summit. Snow depth was 110 cm. Old faceted snow formed the lower 45 cm of the snowpack with a distinctive hard crust 35 cm from the ground. The top of the snowpack was well bonded and right side up. Stability test result: ECTN.
