I kicked around a bit near the edge of the ridge (no <u>cornice</u>) and remote triggered this <u>slide</u> from 20' away. It broke 12-18" deep, and propagated 700-800' wide. Ran full length of the slope into old growth trees 1200' below. Would estimate R4 D3. We found good stable skiing on the south <u>aspect</u> (\sim 35°)"
