Warm Temperatures, Wet Snow in Hyalite

We toured in Hyalite today. By 10:30 in the morning we saw wet, natural avalanches coming down east facing cliffs. We also saw several pinwheels from yesterday. By noon we were at 9,900' on a SE facing <u>aspect</u>, and the snow surface was wet at this altitude. Once we were down at 9,000' the top 8" of snow was wet, and it was beginning to move as a <u>slab</u> on small rollovers.
